### Pete Mihalic, scouted for Phillies for 40 years

'Play ball" was music to the ears of Pete Mihalic. He always looked forward to this time of the year when the major league baseball season opened.

He had been a Philadelphia Phillies scout for 40 years and a member of the Greater Cleveland Sports Hall of Fame. Baseball was in his blood.

Mr. Mihalic, who scouted primarily in Ohio, saw a young ball-player at Ohio University

he thought had profes-sional abilities. He notified the Phillies organization and told them to "sign him." Mike Schmidt was his name and after a outstanding baseball career with Philadelphia, Schmidt is considered a strong candidate to be elected into baseball's hall of fame.
Mr. Mihalic, 81, died Tuesday in Fair-

view Park General Hospital of Parkinson's disease.

He was born in Cleveland, grew up in the E. 62nd St. and St. Clair Ave. neighborhood and most recently lived on W. St. He worked with the Cleveland Water Department for 37 years, retiring in 1978.

Mr. Mihalic began a professional baseball career in 1933 with Fort Wayne, Ind., in the old Central League and was an outstanding minor league hitter. In 1934, he batted .387 and led the league in hitting when playing with the Indians' team in the league.

He played the next few years with a Pennsylvania semipro team, an Arkansas team and in 1937 joined a Kentucky club in the Lonesome Pine League. He batted 382 and led the league in home runs with 29

Mr. Mihalic was drafted into the Army during World War II and served with the Army Special Forces. He became a basescout after the war.

Whether it be a Cleveland sandlot game, or a Cleveland Indians game, it was a sure bet that Mr. Mihalic would be in the stands. In 1988, his health began failing and he gave up his scouting duties with the

He was especially proud of a 1980 Phila-delphia Phillies World Series ring he wore that had been presented to him by the

Baseball memorabilia including trophies, plaques and jackets that Mr. Mihalic received over the years adorn a table near his casket at Walter Martens & Sons funeral home at 9811 Denison Ave.

A bachelor, Mr. Mihalic is survived by a niece.
